Indian Citation Index (ICI), an indigenous Citation Database, comprehensively covers Indian Knowledge contents of journals published from India. It serves R&D community two basic and broad functions: general literature search and evaluation & measurement of R&D productivity (quantitatively and qualitatively) based on counts & citations analysis. Currently 915+ research journals of all disciplines published from India have been indexed with data depth from 2004 onwards. This is an indigenous information product to map and analyse comprehensively Indian R&D output. Indian Citation Index is highly useful for research programs as well as to map & evaluate research productivity of self and other relevant institutions of interest.

Indian Citation Index offers:

- 915+ peer-reviewed Indian journals.
- 503,578 articles.
- 9.2 million References
- Data Depth of Indian Citation Index is about 11 years (2004 +).
